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# **Doggy Daycare/Boarding Checklist**

### **General Rules: Boarding**

- Dogs who have been skunked, have fleas or are exhibiting visible signs of illness cannot be boarded.
- Intact dogs are allowed subject to evaluation. Female dogs in heat cannot be boarded.
- Dogs must be dropped off by 2:00 pm on the day of arrival.
- Dogs must be picked up between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm on the day of departure. Any dog not picked up by 7:00 pm will be boarded overnight for an additional night's boarding fee.
- If you apply topical flea/tick preventative, please allow at least 24 hours between application and boarding drop off.
- Dogs must have a quick-release collar. They can be purchased at Paws-itive.
- No flea collars or plush toys are allowed during boarding.
- Food and treats must be portioned out for each meal, pre-bagged and clearly labelled with your dog's name, amount and feeding frequency. If you like, you may purchase food and treats for your dog from our retail store.
- A current Rabies certificate must be provided.

### **General Rules: Doggy Daycare**

- If your dog is coughing, sneezing, lethargic, vomiting, has diarrhea, or anything else unusual, please leave him/her at home until they feel better. Please call and inform us of any illnesses, as we need to ensure the health of all our members.
- We recommend that dogs be spayed or neutered by 1 year of age. If you plan on keeping your dog intact for any specific reason, it will be placed on a "One Strike" rule. This means if we see ANY aggressive/dominate tendencies, your dog will be asked to leave. This is done for their safety and the safety of other dogs and staff.
- Remember NO females in heat are allowed in daycare!
- If your dog has been in any type of kennel/boarding facility other than Paws-itive, you MUST wait 7 full days before returning to daycare. This is to prevent the risk of illness being brought into our facility. Most transmissible illnesses have an incubation period of 7-10 days.
- If you apply topical flea/tick preventative, please allow 24 hours after applying before returning to daycare.
- Your dog must be current on his/her rabies vaccination, and you must provide an updated copy of the Rabies certificate to our office.

## **Additional Information**

- Payment arrangements must be made before your dog leaves unless we are holding a current credit card number on file.
- Please make sure you update us if your card is lost/stolen or the expiration date changes.
- Please potty your dog before bringing them into daycare. Dogs get excited on the ride here and usually have to go. Use any of the potty areas: outside the door on the rocks, or around the fenced in area. Pooper scoopers are available for use at those locations.
- If, for any reason, you are unable to bring your dog up or down the stairs, let us know and we can do it for you. This means your dog can still play and get tired and you don't have to worry about going up and down the stairs with an excited pooch.

## **Bus**

Bus rides are done in a 10-mile radius from Paws-itive. The cost is \$15/home each way. The bus service must be booked or cancelled 24 hours in advance, otherwise additional fees may be charged. The driver will need detailed instructions and a key to your home. If the bus driver arrives and your dog is not acting right, or it is apparent that topical preventative has been applied, we reserve the right to not take the dog(s) and you will be contacted immediately with our findings.

## **Dog Play**

- Dogs play with their mouth and paws. Sometimes they will come home with scrapes or scratches which occur while they are playing. It is very important to keep your dog's nails cut short to ensure that they will not cause excessive harm to another dog or to the staff. We have professional groomers on staff. If your dog needs a nail trim, please ask about scheduling an appointment during their stay.
- Please note: If the staff feels that your dog's nails are long enough to be a danger to the staff or another dog, we will trim your dog's nails. The cost of this will be \$20.
- Dogs in daycare play hard and will be very thirsty when they come home, even though they receive water regularly throughout the day while playing with their friends. Give small amounts of water when you get home to reduce the chances of vomiting or bloat.
